However, he was called up for The Great War. He was killed in action at Poitiers in France on December 28, 1916. Sir Harry wrote the song, Keep Right on to the End of the Road in the aftermath of John's death. He also wrote a number of books which ran into several editions, including Harry Lauder at Home and on Tour (1912), A Minstrel in France (1918), and Between You and...
